Where: Situated at the Rhine, Mainz has currently about 230.000 citizens. Mainz University has about 570 full professors and 31.000 students, and is in easy reach of Frankfurt airport.

Who can apply: Scheduled for 8 B.Sc./M.Sc. students & 4 PhD students from SuZ (Biology or related)

Financial support by DAAD: 294 € for B.Sc./M.Sc. students, 378 € for PhD students

Training: Computational analyses of phylogeny and sequence evolution on proteins and coding sequences

The focus will be on mammals and especially primates but other groups will be considered too. We will additionally carry out phylogenetic exercises on skull models. The methods can be applied to any group of organisms.

Language: English – There will be additional participants from Mainz University

Benefit: Certificate of participation. ECTS are awarded according to decisions of the University of Zagreb





